## 6 Current challenges

**Innovation** - the likelihood that a UK SME will innovate decreased from 48% in 2017 to 35% in 2021.<sup>2</sup>

**Net zero adoption** - Just over a third of UK SMEs are not engaged in undertaking any active steps to reduce their business's carbon footprint

Current net zero support schemes are only reaching 1% of the SME population.

**Workplace wellbeing** - 37% of firms surveyed in 2023 said that they had experienced 'presenteeism', compared to 21 per cent in 2022

Spatial variation in innovation - firms reporting the highest innovation are concentrated in an 'arc of innovation' stretching across the SE Midlands and along the M4 corridor<sup>3</sup>



ERC research has showed that left unaddressed, poor mental health can cut productivity by a quarter
